Reduced- or Full-Price Meals

Parents are encouraged to purchase a month's or multiple days' worth of meals at one time. Payments may be made in the office, payable to Wilson Creek School District. At this time, only cash or check are accepted.

Free Meals (See also Appendix – Exhibit I and IA)

At the beginning of each month the secretary or office manager will verify any updates that have been made to the Skyward system regarding to eligibility changes for free and/or reduced-price meals.

A la Carte Meals (Adults only)

Adults have the option of purchasing partial meals rather than a full meal. A la Carte prices are in 25¢ increments as indicated below:
