- 7-11th GRADE: Check Out Forms will be given to students June 13th during their first period classes. Seniors, your check out forms will be in the office to pick up when you are available. If you are planning to not be here on June 13th, please see your first period teacher or Stacy in the office for a Check Out Form. Each student will need to make sure to return any and all text books, library books, calculators, any school property and pay any and all outstanding lunch fees that day. Each student will need to make sure that they have signatures from each of their teachers to properly finish out the year. Report card and or transcripts will be held until all fines are paid.
- 7-11th GRADE: If your schedule is not received or returned to the office by June 12, your core classes will be the only classes scheduled for the new year. If not returned a meeting with Ms. Nelson will be scheduled to discuss your elective options on the first day of school. Not returning this form may leave you at risk to be denied entry into the class you desired, and an elective class assigned/scheduled for you. Seniors/Juniors take a moment and visit Ms. Nelson to check if your Visual Arts and Science credits are aligned for graduation.
- ALL 9-11 GRADE STUDENTS: Reminder, you will need to have community service hours in order to graduate. Freshmen, you need 10; Sophomores, you will need 15; Juniors, you will need 20; and Seniors, you will need 25. You may earn them yearly or wait until you are a senior (and then, it will be 70!) to earn them. Forms are in Miss Floetke's room. You need a supervising adult to sign off. Remember, Community Service hours are unpaid hours you work for someone/something/someplace/some organization.
