- ALL SECONDARY: Students are not allowed on the playground toys at lunchtime. Students should be only in the gym or commons, **and be visible to the supervisor**.
- ALL: Students are not allowed to be using the weight room without adult one-on-one supervision.
- ALL: Students are not allowed to be on the upper playground prior to school starting without adult supervision.
- ALL SECONDARY: Payment of ASB dues are required for participation in athletics, FFA, FBLA and some ASB activities. Make sure yours are taken care of soon!
- ALL: After school, all students must leave the school buildings and go home or have permission from parents to go to a friend's house unless staying with a teacher or coach.
