FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This is meant to clarify the eligibility for this school year. Grades for students receiving a "D" or an "F" will be sent to the athletic director on Monday of each week. The list will be finalized by the AD and the district secretary no later than 9:00 A.M. on Tuesday. Students on probation or that are ineligible will have a letter sent home. The students will be on probation or ineligible from Wednesday morning until the list is reissued and takes effect the following Wednesday morning. Athletes that are ineligible may practice with the team but may not travel with the team or participate in any home events.

The biggest change is that any student earning an "F" in any class will not be allowed to go on any field trips until we are notified via the next grade check that they are now eligible. If the field trip will be a part of their grade the teacher will provide an alternative assignment that they can complete while they are at school.
