WILSON CREEK SCHOOL MORNING BULLETIN: WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 20, 2017

- **10-12 STUDENTS:** If you are legally driving to and from the school, the office **MUST** have a copy of your license, insurance and description of the car you are driving.
- **9-12 STUDENTS:** If you live in the town of Wilson Creek and want to leave campus during lunch, you **MUST** turn in your permission note to do so!
- **9-12 GRADE:** Now is the time to be thinking about whether or not you have completed your **community service** hours for the year. REMEMBER, as a 9th grader you need 10 hours, 10th graders need 15 hours, 11th graders need 20 hours, and 12th graders need 25 hours. Please do not wait until your senior year to get them done. Some of you have already done them, you just need the paperwork signed. Please take care of this, it is your responsibility to do so.
- **FROM THE KITCHEN:** Students are NOT allowed to take lunch trays out of the cafeteria, this includes to the outdoor seating area.
- **ELIGIBILITY:** This is meant to clarify the eligibility for this school year. Grades for students receiving a “D” or an “F” will be sent to the athletic director on Monday of each week. The list will be finalized by the AD and the district secretary no later than 9:00 A.M. on Tuesday. Students on probation or that are ineligible will have a letter sent home. The students will be on probation or ineligible from Wednesday morning until the list is reissued and takes effect the following Wednesday morning. Athletes that are ineligible may practice with the team but may not travel with the team or participate in any home events.

The biggest change is that any student earning an “F” in any class will not be allowed to go on any field trips until we are notified via the next grade check that they are now eligible. If the field trip will be a part of their grade the teacher will provide an alternative assignment that they can complete while they are at school.
