



Wilson Creek School Student's Supply List

The elementary teachers have provided the following list of materials that they would like their students to have for the 2007-2008 school year. (Remember, it is always a good idea to label your child's items with their name.)

Preschoolers – Mrs. Ribail

- ⇒ A zippered backpack or school bag large enough to hold a big library book. (Please label.) Zippered bags are preferred because snaps, drawstrings, and clasps are difficult for this age group.
- ⇒ A box of Kleenex.
- ⇒ **An extra set of “dry” clothes, socks, and underwear.** Please label. (Accidents do happen.)

Kindergarten - Mrs. Dammel

- ⇒ A zippered backpack or school bag large enough to hold a big library book. (Zippered bags are preferred because snaps, drawstrings, and clasps are difficult for this age group.) **PLEASE, NOT TOO LARGE!** Bags with rollers work well also. PLEASE LABEL WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON THE OUTSIDE.
- ⇒ Several #2 pencils. (No pencil sharpeners needed.)
- ⇒ A box of CRAYOLA crayons - **16 colors only**, please.
- ⇒ A box of Kleenex
- ⇒ Glue sticks...optional.
- ⇒ **An extra set of “dry” clothes, socks, and underwear.** Accidents and wet weather happen. (Please label.)
- ⇒ A pair of clean tennis shoes & white socks for gym use.
- ⇒ We will supply a pencil box, glue, scotch tape, safety scissors, etc. so you don't need to send these items.

Also, please encourage your child to leave toys at home. They may get lost or broken and are not allowed in the classroom once daily class begins.

1-2nd Graders – Mrs. Kane

- ⇒ School Backpack or Book bag (label, please)
- ⇒ 1 16-count crayons (label, please)
- ⇒ 2 Boxes of Kleenex tissue (Large flat, rectangular size)
- ⇒ 3 Dozen #2 Pencils
- ⇒ 1 Pack of Markers
- ⇒ 1 Spiral Notebook
- ⇒ 3 Pink Pearl Erasers
- ⇒ 3 Two-pocket folders
- ⇒ 1 Package College Ruled Notebook Paper
- ⇒ 1 Box Ziplock Sandwich Baggies
- ⇒ 1 Tub of Baby Wipes
- ⇒ 1 Pair of Gym Shoes (old CLEAN tennis shoes are fine – please label)
- ⇒ 1 Pair of White Socks for gym shoes (please label)

Community Supplies

- ⇒ 2-3 dozen #2 pencils – Please sharpen at home (more will be needed later in the year)
- ⇒ 2 dry erase markers
- ⇒ 1 highlighter
- ⇒ 4 pads of post it notes
- ⇒ 3 pink pearl erasers
- ⇒ Large box of tissue

Individual Supplies

- ⇒ 2 Mead composition books – **these are wide-ruled notebooks with cardboard covers. They do not have spiral bindings and they don't have perforated pages. Other brands are available.**
- ⇒ 4 two-pocket folders (pee-chee type)
- ⇒ Backpack
- ⇒ Pencil Box (no larger than 5” x 9”)
- ⇒ Scissors
- ⇒ A self-contained individual hand pencil sharpener

Optional – for personal use

- ⇒ Glue sticks, markers

Optional - for community use

- ⇒ “sealed” healthy snacks (pretzels, fruit leather etc)
- ⇒ 1 box sandwich size zip-lock baggies
- ⇒ 1 box gallon size zip-lock baggies

- ⇒ 3 Spiral Notebook (wide rule; @ 70 pages)
- ⇒ 5 Pee Chee type folders
- ⇒ 2 Folders (with metal clasp and pocket in front & back cover)
- ⇒ Notebook paper (wide rule) (500 sheets)
- ⇒ 1 Large box of Kleenex
- ⇒ 1 Zip lock organizer bag or pouch (not a box) to hold the following:
 - ~ eraser, scissors, glue, pencil sharpener
 - ~ colored pencils, crayons, and markers for map work & designs
 - ~ 2 blue or black ink pens
 - ~ 1 dozen #2 pencils
 - ~ 1 mechanical pencil may be allowed
 - ~ 1 inexpensive solar calculator
